- ELIGIBILITY** Open to those photographers who deliver up to two works to the Watchung Arts Center. We welcome all photography-based imagery.
- INSTRUCTIONS** Bring the actual works, up to 2 pieces, completed entry coupons, fee, and a self-addressed/stamped envelope to Watchung Arts Center on October 31, between 1-4pm. Each finished work can be no wider than 45 inches **including** frame. Works *must* be professionally presented, framed and properly wired for hanging. **No clip frames or clips holding the wire.** Any piece larger than 20x24 should have plexi & a sturdy frame; otherwise, we cannot be responsible for breakage. Insurance is not provided at either venue. Artists wishing insurance need to provide it themselves. The NJPF, WAC and the CS Hospital are not responsible for work. Exhibit moves to Children's Specialized Hospital in Mountainside for months of December and January.
- FEE** **For up to 2 works:** \$20. Checks must be made out to Nancy Ori.
- DEADLINES** Receiving day..... Saturday, October 31, 1 - 4 pm
Opening reception..... Sunday, November 8, 1 - 4 pm
